

Art Submission Information Pack

Q: What types of media can I submit?

A: Drawing, sketches, painting on paper, painting on canvas, textile, writing, photography and poetry are all welcome.

Q: How many works can I submit, and what size can they be?

A: You may submit up to 2 works, each no bigger than A1.

Q: What is the maximum image size I can send via email?

A: The maximum image size that can be sent via email is 20 MB.

Q: Do I need to provide images of my artwork?

A: Yes, all submissions must include a picture of the artwork. Accepted file types are JPG, PDF, or a link to your work online.

Q: Will I get confirmation that their submission has been received?

A: Yes, you will receive a confirmation email from the curators.

Q: Who installs the artwork in the gallery?

A: The curators will install the artwork. Artists can provide specific installation instructions in the submission form. You may also install your own work, but the placement in the gallery will be decided by the curators.

Q: Is there a submission fee, and are any costs covered?

A: There is no submission fee. No materials, shipping, or production costs are covered, so artists are responsible for any expenses.

Q: How will artworks be selected?

A: Works are selected based on relevance to the exhibition themes and quality. All submissions will receive a response.

Q: What are the drop off and collection date and times?

A: Drop-off: 14th May, from 9:30am to 4:00pm. **Collection:** 30th May, from 9:30am to 1pm.

Q: Will my artwork be photographed or promoted?

A: Yes, artworks displayed in the gallery will be photographed for documentation and social media promotion. If this is a problem, please indicate it in the submission form.

Q: Who can I contact if I have questions or need support?

Q: Who is responsible for delivering and collecting artworks?

A: Artists are responsible for delivering their works to the gallery and collecting them after the exhibition.

Q: Is my artwork insured while on display?

A: While we take care when handling and displaying artworks, we cannot provide insurance or accept liability for any damage. Artists are encouraged to arrange their own insurance if required.

Q: Can artworks be sold as part of the exhibition?

A: Yes, artworks can be for sale. Artists are responsible for handling sales directly. If a work is sold, it must remain on display for the full duration of the exhibition. Please indicate in the submission form if your work is for sale and include pricing information if applicable. The curators and ASC will not take any fees for sales.

Selected artists will receive full information about participation, including terms and conditions.
